Specialist Dentistry.

We offer a broad range of routine and advanced dental care at Berkhamsted Dental Practice. Partners Claire Rogers and John O'Grady are specialists in Paedodontics and Prosthodontics respectively. We also refer patients to visiting specialists Giles Kidner (orthodontist) and Philip Mitchell (endodontist) who operate their specialists practices from our premises in Lower Kings Road.



Dental Nurse Caroline joins the team in December. We are delighted to welcome her to the practice.

Paedodontics is dentistry for Children. Claire can provide a range of treatment for children and young people including those who have special needs or are anxious about seeing a dentist.

Prosthodontics is the replacement of missing and damaged teeth. John can provide a range of crowns, veneers, bridges and dentures. He can also provide advice about implants.

Orthodontics is all about straightening crooked teeth. Giles can provide a range of braces including various "invisible" options.

Endodontics is the science of root filling teeth. Phil can carry out root fillings and surgery to help preserve teeth where the nerve has died or become infected. Without such treatment these teeth would need to be extracted.
